

Required Assignment, Week 2, 1st Grade:

Ms. DeJesus had 3 bags of erasers, and she was wondering how many erasers she had. Her son, Eli, organized them and counted them for her. This is what he did:



He organized the erasers into groups of 10 and got:

4 tens & 4 erasers + 2 tens & 4 erasers + 2 tens. Or $44 + 24 + 20$

He added all the tens and got 8 groups of ten erasers and 8 erasers. So, he knew the total number of erasers Ms. DeJesus had were 88.

Your job is to find two or three collections of things in your house. Then you need to organize them to figure out how many there are in each collection!
